PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME -- GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: The approach of Hurricane Ike to areas of the Gulf Coast, and its projected path through Texas and eventually across Arkansas, already have caused disruption to the supply of gasoline and other products essential to the people of Arkansas and other states; and


WHEREAS: Arkansas law, specifically Arkansas Code Annotated Sections 4-88-301 *et seq.*, provides protection to consumers from persons and businesses engaged in price gouging and unfair pricing practices during and shortly after a declaration of a state of emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKE BEEBE, Governor of the State of Arkansas, do hereby declare a state of emergency to exist in the entire State of Arkansas due to the aforementioned adverse effects of Hurricane Ike.
