

### THE FEDERAL HEARING EXEMPTION RENEWAL PROCESS

#### Dear Sir/Madam:

If you have been issued a Federal exemption from the hearing standard under 49 CFR 391.41(b)(11) and you would like to renew it, you must submit the following information no later than 3 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE listed on the current exemption. If the information is submitted past this date, there is a chance that you will have a lapse in your ability to operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce. FMCSA must have adequate time to process your renewal request.

Please submit the following information:

- 1. A written request to renew your hearing exemption.
- 2. A legible copy of your driver's license, front and back.
- 3. A legible copy of your driving record for the last 3 years from your state licensing authority. If you were involved in any crash or were convicted for any moving violation, provide additional official documentation (e.g., a copy of the crash report or the citation, or copies of court records).
- 4. Completed and signed Authorization for Release of Medical Information Form.

- 5. A legible copy of your Medical Examiner's Certificate, MCSA-5876 indicating that a hearing exemption is required.
- 6. A legible copy of your current exemption.
