# Medical Review Board Task 21–2: Non-Insulin Treated Diabetes Mellitus Assessment Form

#### I. Task Title

Review of form for Medical Examiners on the National Registry to assess and clinically evaluate commercial motor vehicle (CMV) driver applicants with Non-Insulin Treated Diabetes Mellitus (Non-ITDM).

### II. Background

FMCSA receives frequent inquiries from medical examiners regarding the physical qualification determination of non-ITDM individuals. The Non-ITDM Assessment Form is an optional tool to assist medical examiners in the clinical assessment and evaluation of non-ITDM individuals. Similar to the CMV Driver Medication Form MCSA 5895, medical examiners would use the Non-ITDM Assessment Form at their discretion to communicate with treating clinicians of non-ITDM individuals during the physical qualification examination process. The form would be completed by the non-ITDM individual's treating clinician.

## III. Task

FMCSA directs the MRB to review and comment on whether the information on the proposed Non-ITDM Assessment Form would provide provides sufficient information concerning the treatment, control, and stability, of an individual's non-ITDM condition to assist a medical examiner in making an appropriate physical qualification determination. Please identify any areas of ambiguity as well as additional information that FMCSA should include on the form.
