## EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING HURRICANE IDA MANDATORY EVACUATION

- WHEREAS,** the National Weather Service has issued a Hurricane Warning and Storm Surge Warning to the Louisiana Gulf Coast, including St. Charles Parish, regarding the potential landfall of Hurricane Ida which is expected to be a major hurricane at landfall.
- WHEREAS,** Hurricane Ida is expected to make landfall in Louisiana on or about August 29, 2021, with likely impact to St. Charles Parish.
- WHEREAS,** Governor John Bel Edwards declared a State of Emergency pertaining to Hurricane Ida, which is expected to make landfall along the Louisiana Gulf Coast on or about August 29, 2021.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, MATTHEW JEWELL,** St. Charles Parish President, considering the emergency advisories issued by the National Weather Service and the emergency declaration by Governor John Bel Edwards, does hereby order and direct as follows:

**A Mandatory Evacuation for all areas of St. Charles Parish effective August 28, 2021, at 6:00 a.m. for all residents and visitors until it is determined that it is safe to return.**

**It is further recommended that during this mandatory evacuation that all residents monitor the Parish website and local news if possible, regarding instructions, information and updates as they become available.**

**These restrictions shall remain in effect temporarily until it is determined that it is safe to remove them.**
