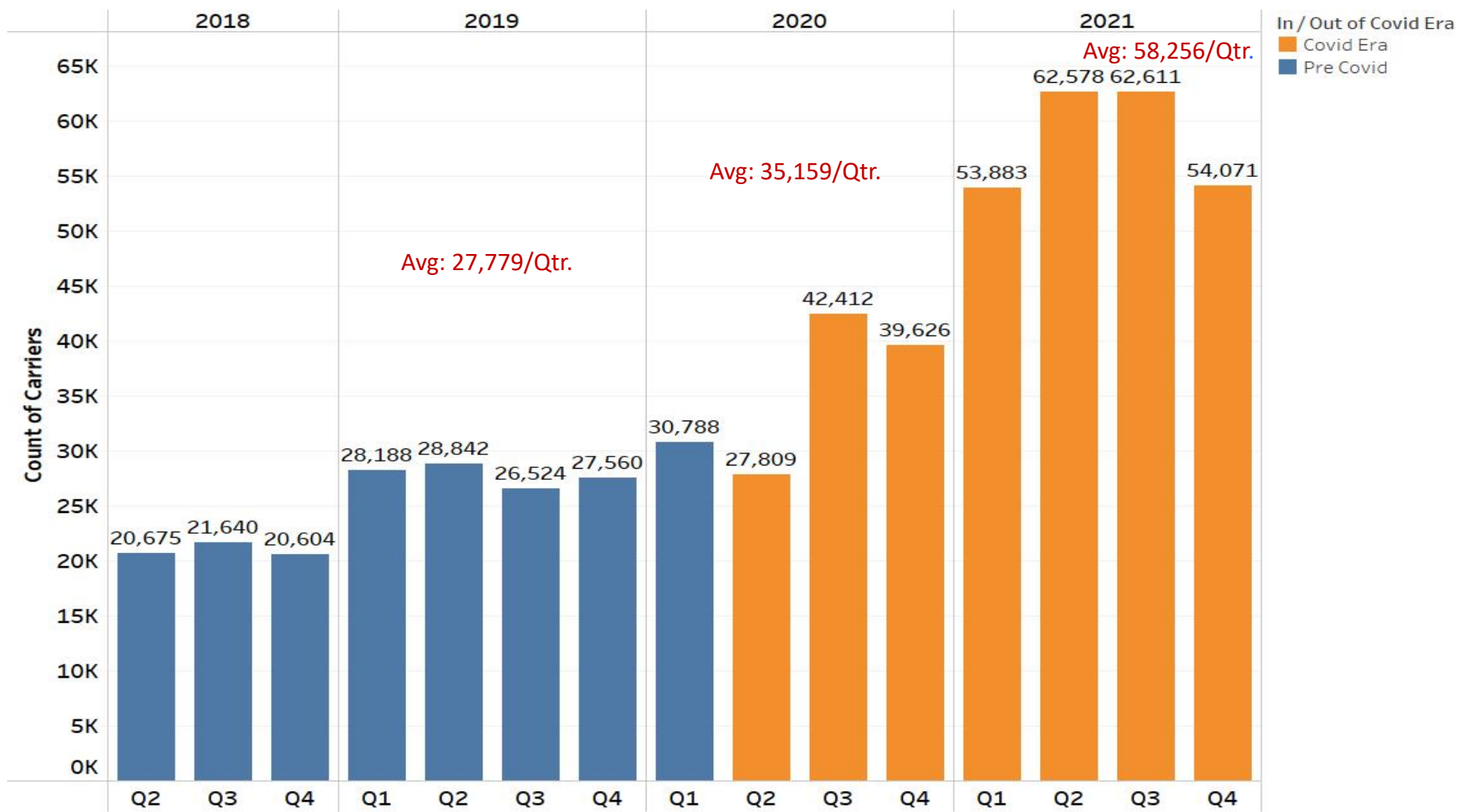

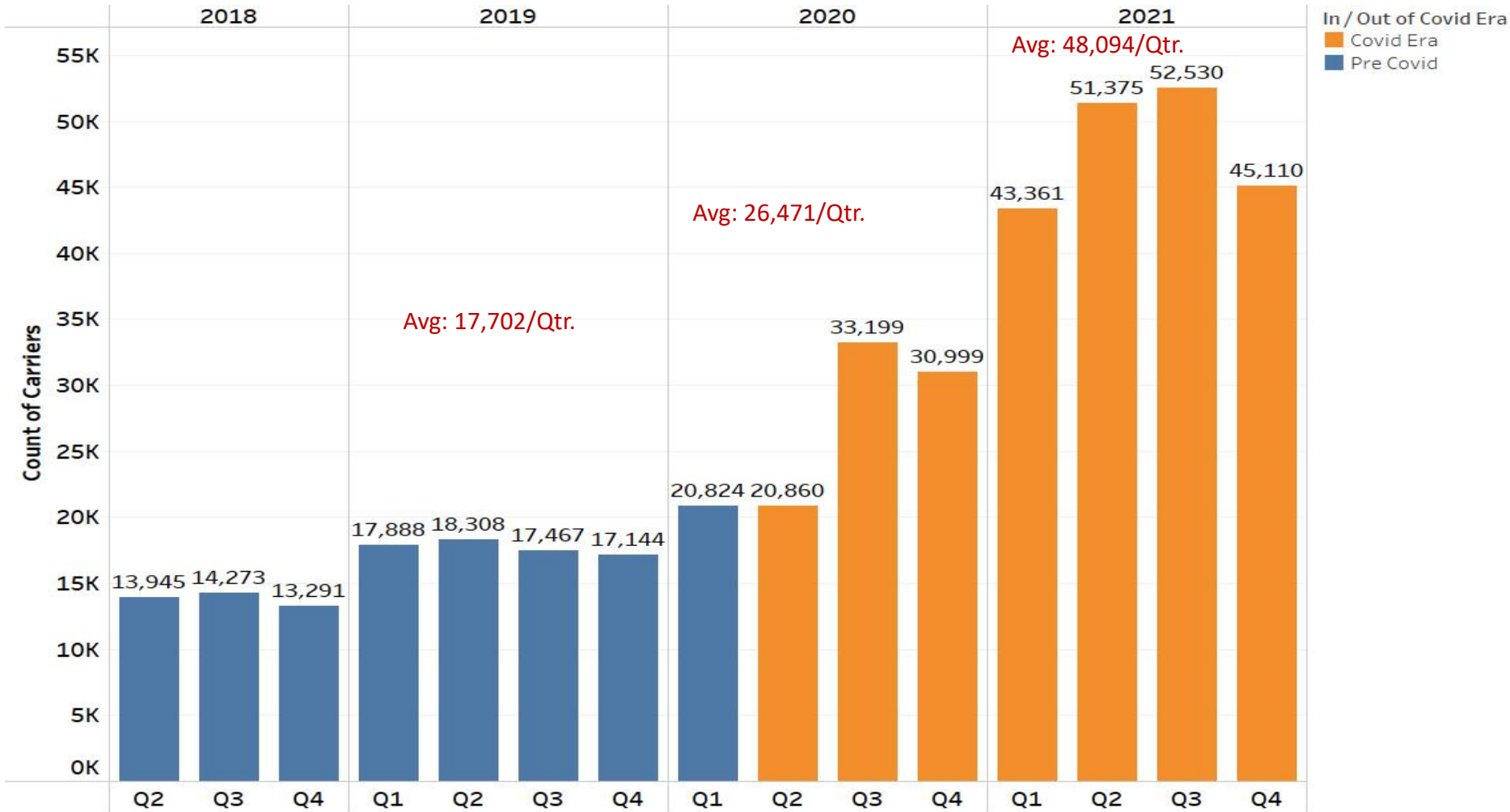


New Carriers Added to MCMIS Between (Apr 2018 – Dec 2021) By Quarter



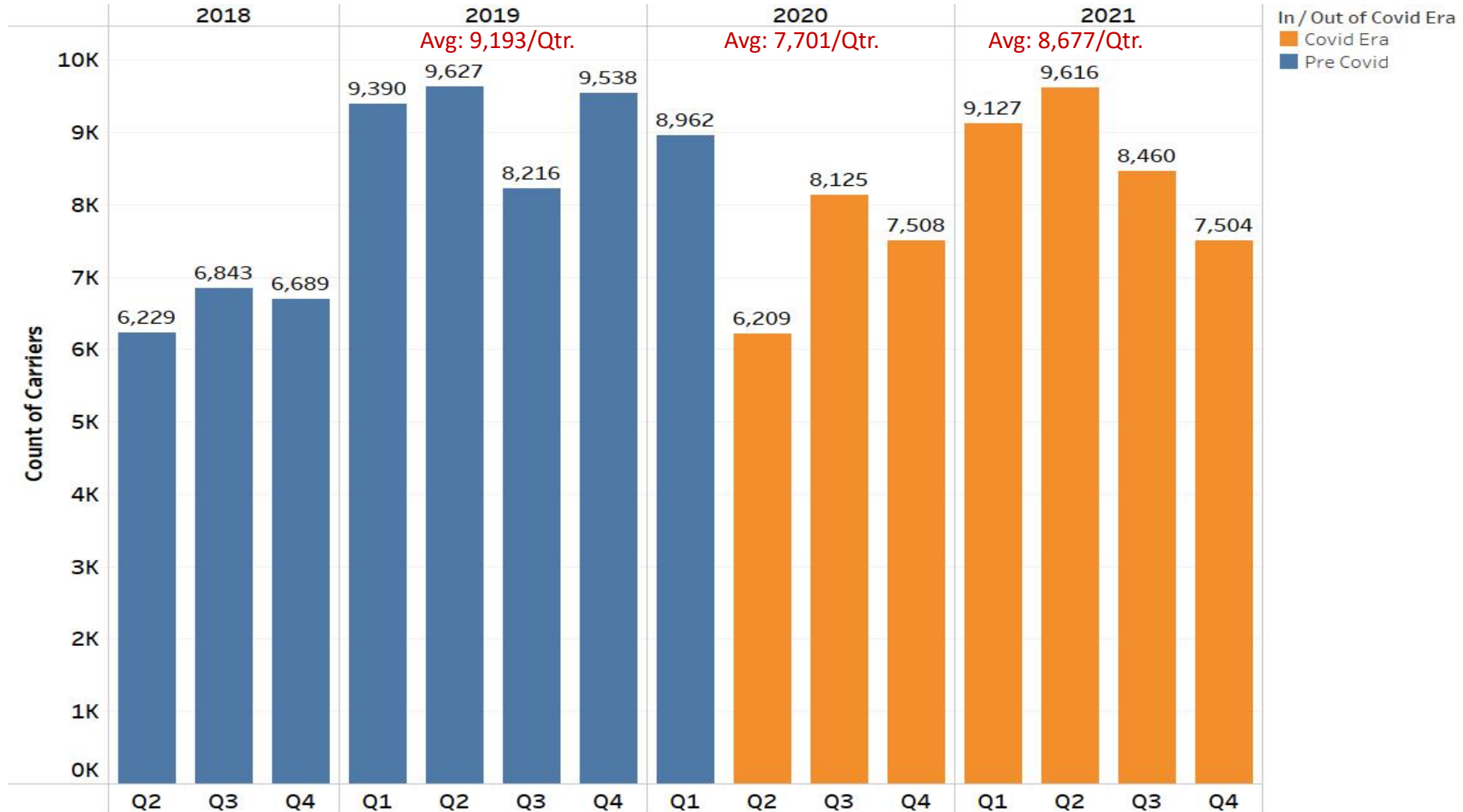

New For-hire Carriers Added to MCMIS Between (Apr 2018 – Dec 2021) By Quarter



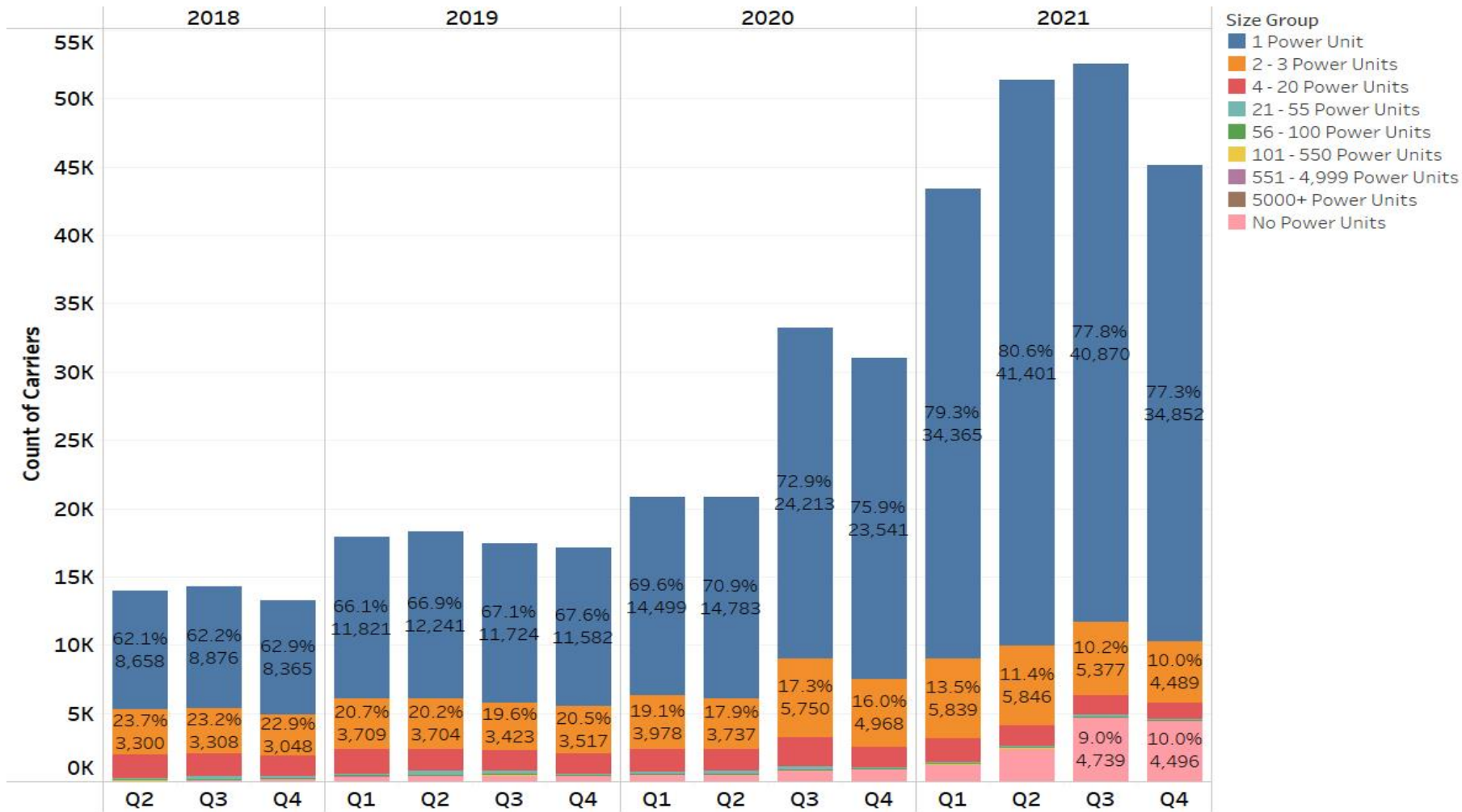

New Private Only Carriers Added to MCMIS Between (Apr 2018 – Dec 2021) By Quarter



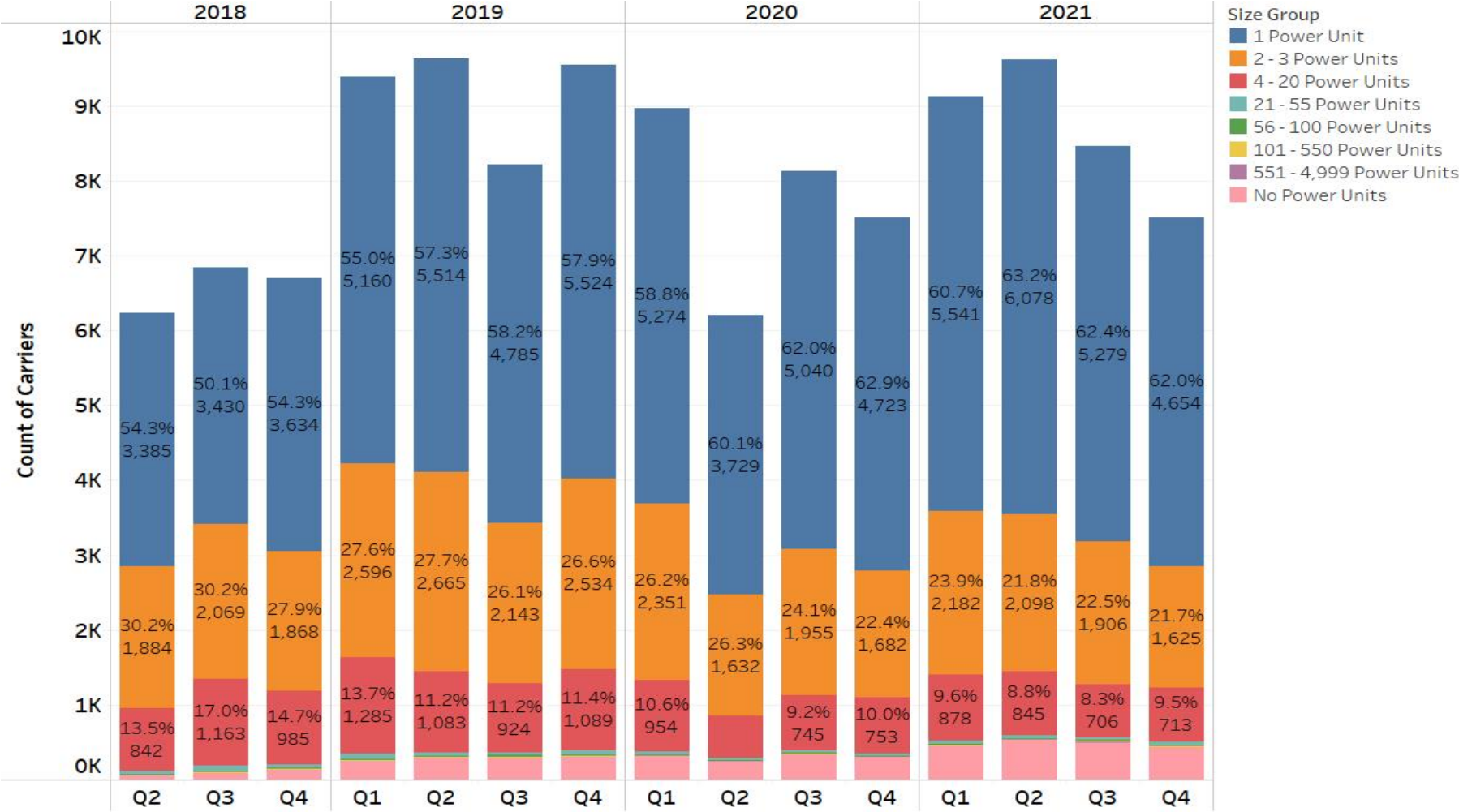

New For-hire Carriers Added to MCMIS Between (Apr 2018 – Dec 2021) by Carrier Size



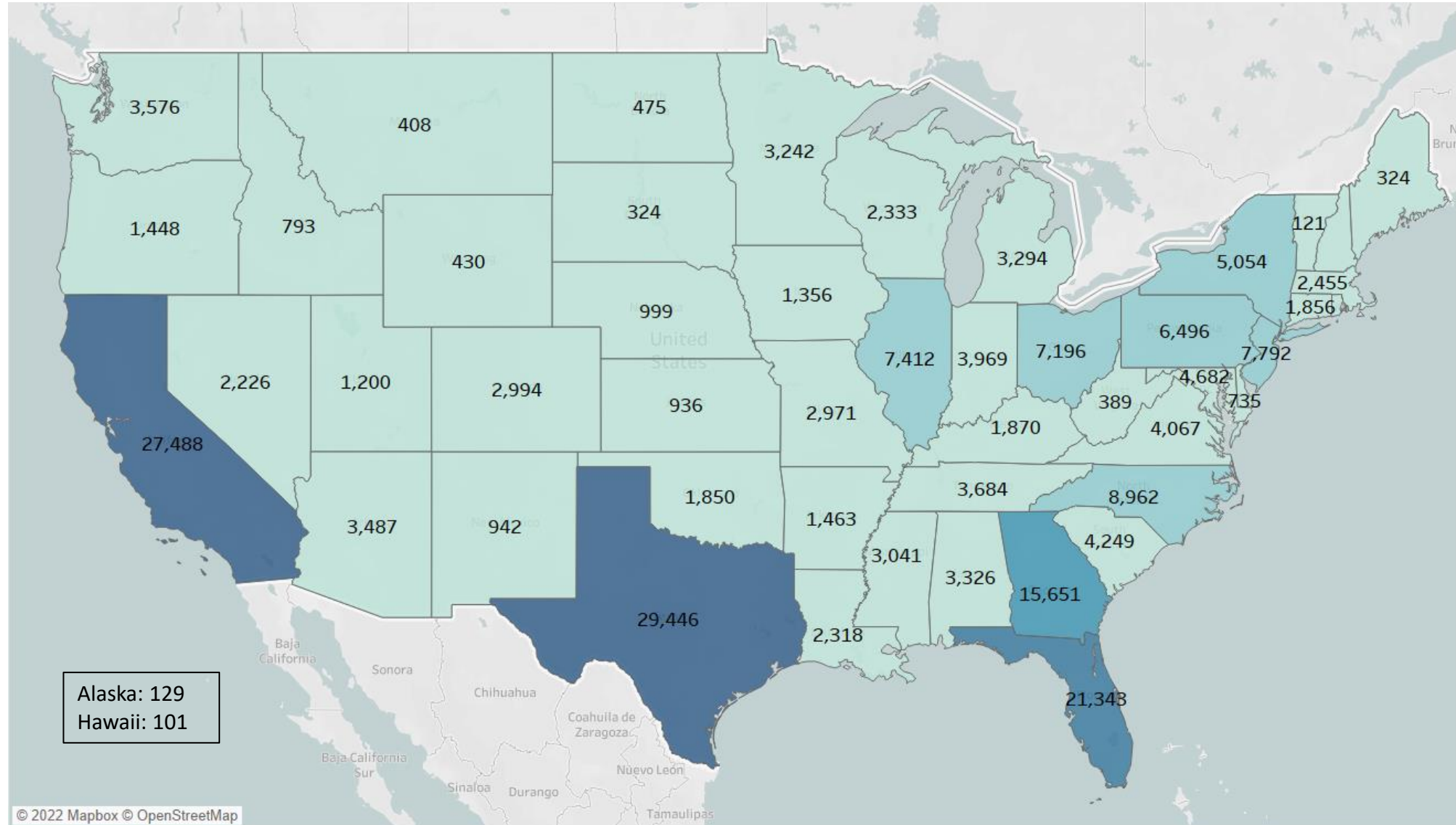

Total For-hire Carriers (with Only 1 Power Unit) Added to MCMIS Between (Apr 2020 – Dec 2021) by State

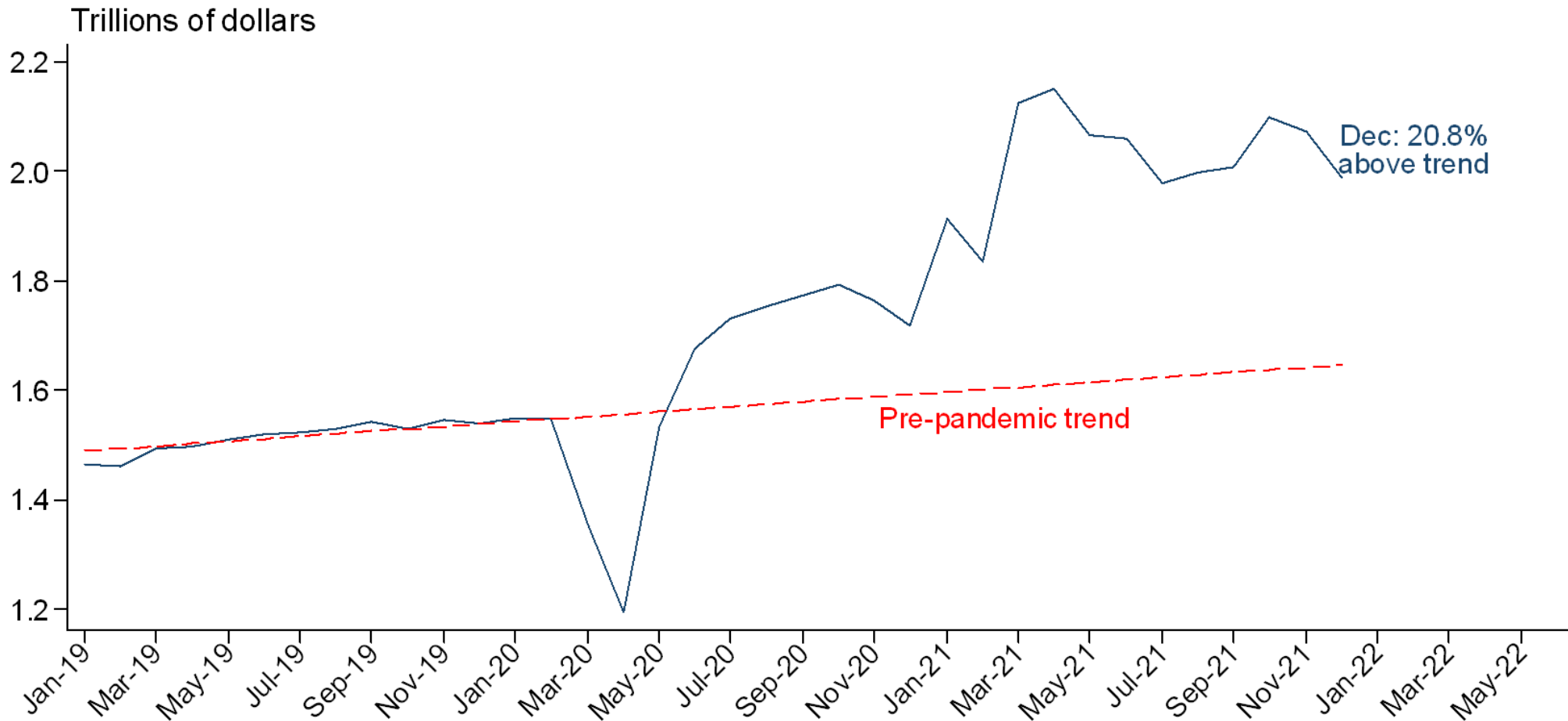

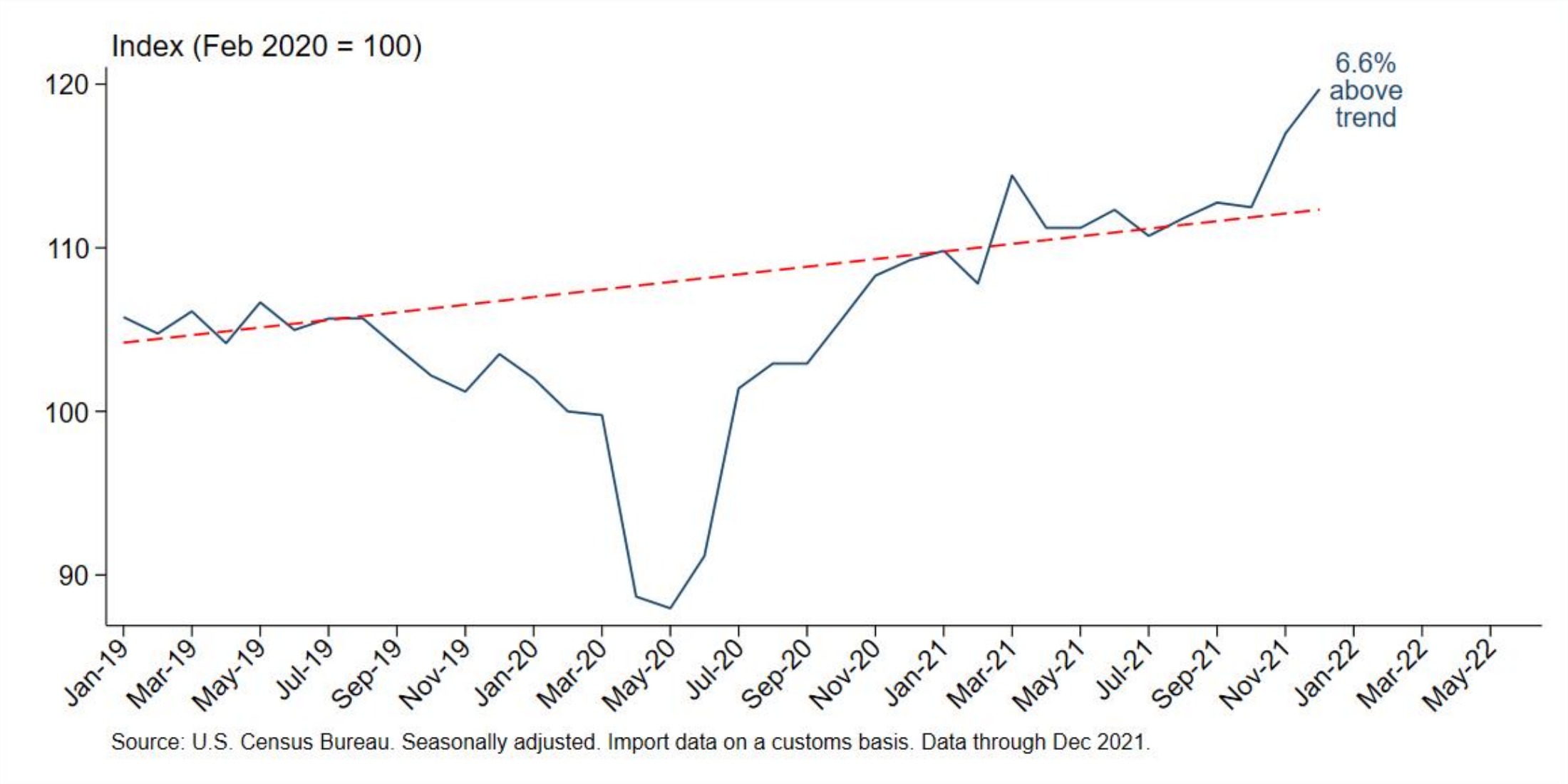
Consumer Durable Goods Purchases

U.S. Goods Imports (Real)

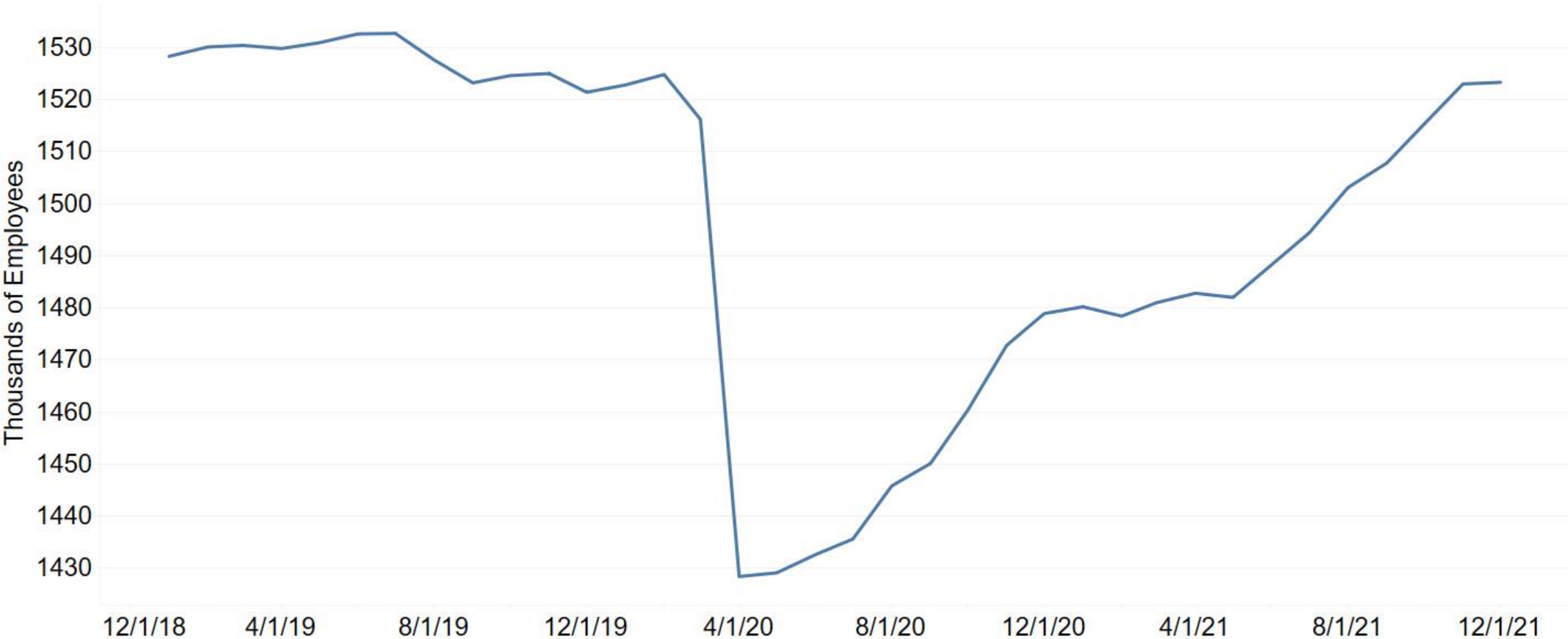


Trucking Employment Supply has rebounded in response

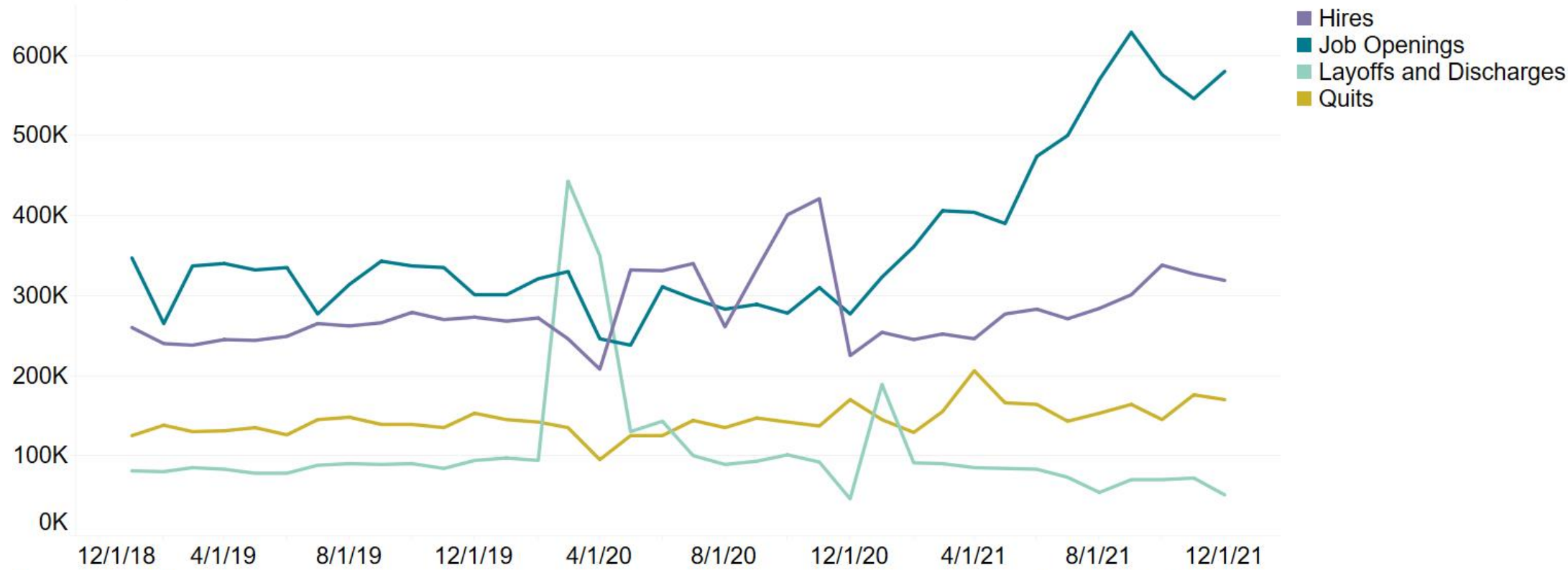

Job Openings and Labor Turnover: Transportation, Warehousing, and Utilities Sector (Seasonally Adjusted)

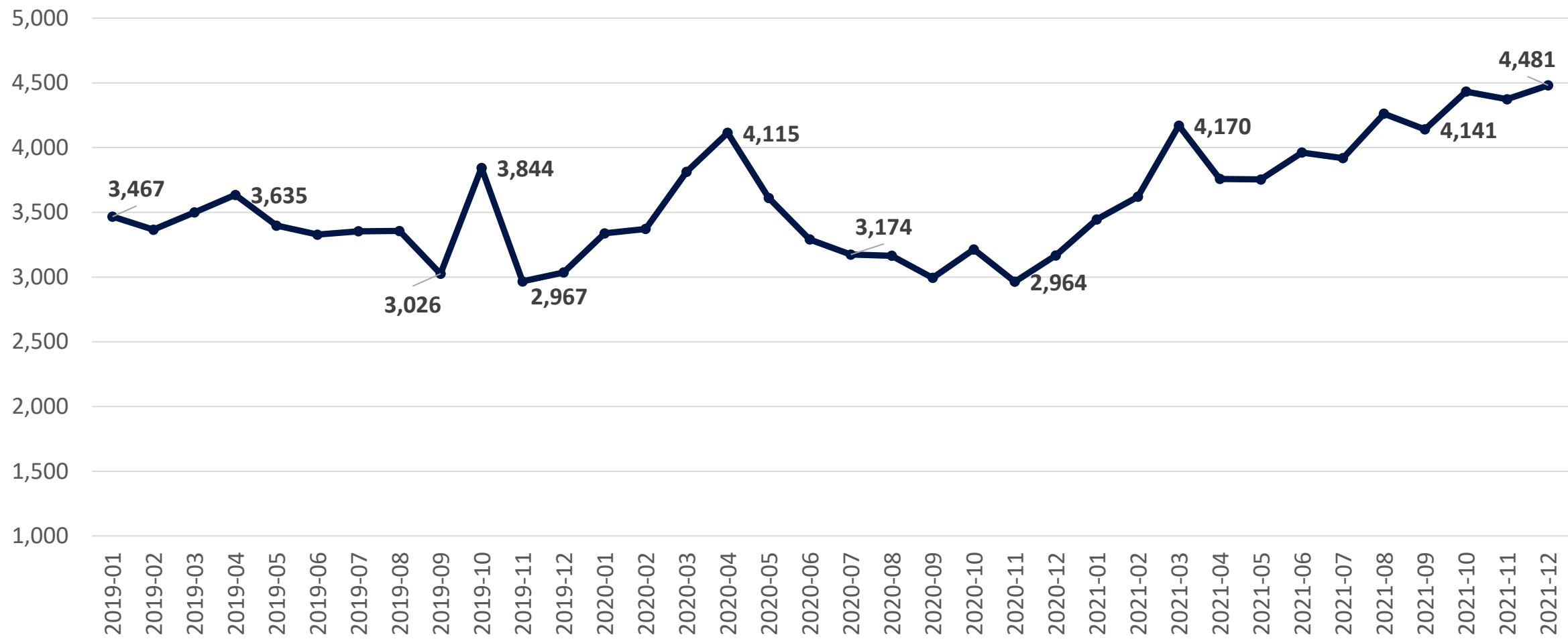

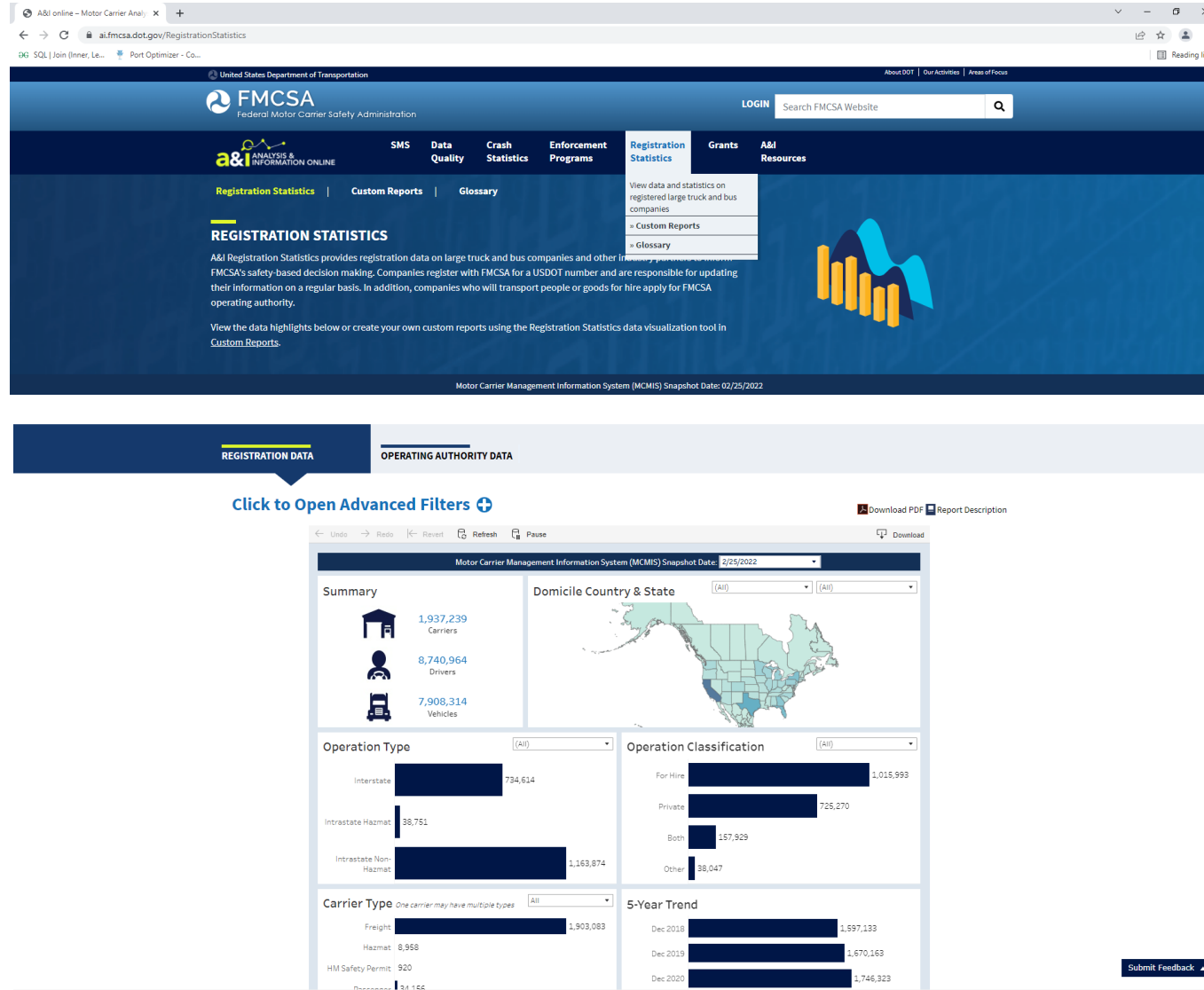

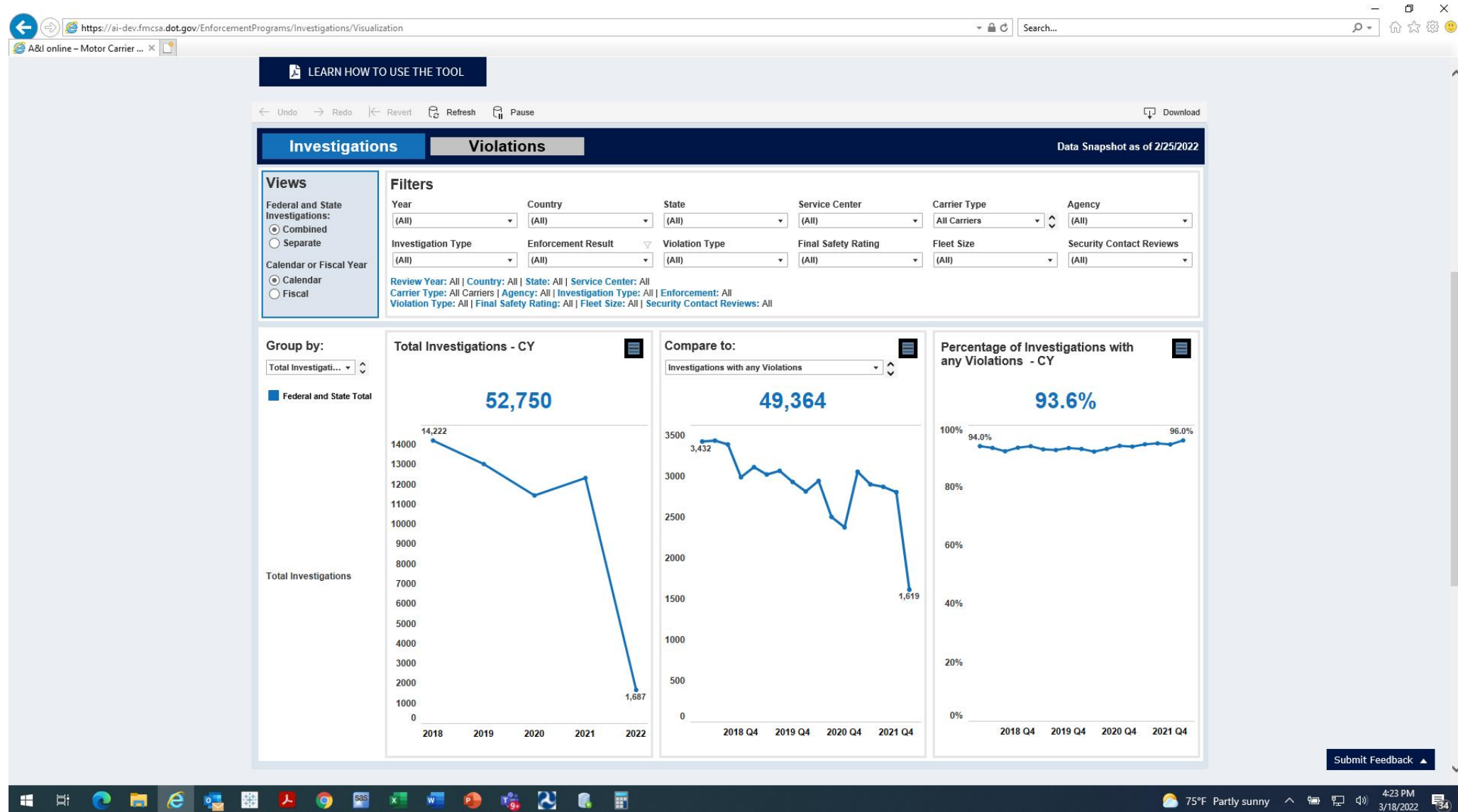
