Initiative Overview

Our Roads, Our Safety Summary

Our Roads, Our Safety is a national safety campaign led by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) to raise awareness about sharing the road safely with all road users, especially large trucks and buses. The Our Roads, Our Safety campaign supports FMCSA's mission of reducing crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving large trucks and buses. As part of this effort, FMCSA partners with other organizations to educate all drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians on the importance of sharing the road.

As part of these efforts, FMCSA also provides resources to educate and reinforce safe driving behaviors with all drivers, and in particular, those driving large trucks and buses. This playbook contains messages and materials to encourage drivers to slow down and follow the speed limit.

Publishing Strategy

Encouraging the public to maintain safe speeds can be flowed into your content strategy at any point in the year. We also recommend utilizing this content around times we know more drivers are on the roads, such as summer, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and winter holidays.

When publishing this content, we encourage you to use **#OurRoads** with your posts to help engage in the larger *Our Roads*, *Our Safety* conversation.



Curves and Ramps

- Curves and ramps can be unsafe when driving too fast. Always slow down and approach them at a safe speed.
 Keep #OurRoads safe. #SlowDown
- For large trucks and buses, curves and ramps can present challenges. Stay safe by following the posted speed limit and slowing down when on #OurRoads. #SlowDown
