## **FMCSA Grant Application Process**

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) provides several financial assistance opportunities, through five <u>discretionary</u> <u>grant programs</u>, to support activities and projects that enhance motor carrier safety and/or advance innovative transportation technology. Interested parties must apply and compete for funding.

STEP 2	•	<ul> <li>View Notice of Funding Opportunities (NOFOs)</li> <li>FMCSA posts all available grants on <u>Grants.gov</u> as NOFOs.</li> <li>Subscribe to FMCSA grant announcements through Grants.gov.</li> <li>Use the <u>Search Grants</u> function to view NOFOs.</li> <li>Type "FMCSA" in the Keyword(s) box.</li> <li>To view grants available to Minority Institutions of Higher Education (MIHEs), select "Private Institutions of Higher Education" and/or "Public and State Institutions of Higher Education" under the "Eligibility" criteria.</li> </ul>
STEP 3		<ul> <li>Complete Registration Steps</li> <li>Takes several weeks to complete. Approval times vary.</li> <li>1. All applicants must register with <u>SAM.gov</u>.</li> <li>2. All Applicants must register on <u>Grants.gov</u> through <u>Workspace</u> to apply to NOFOs.</li> <li>Complete these steps early to avoid missing an application deadline.</li> </ul>
STEP 4	•	<ul> <li>Complete the Application</li> <li>Application submission deadlines are published in the NOFO.</li> <li>Complete the application through your Workspace account.</li> <li>Check out the Grants.gov blog for application tips.</li> <li>Save your application often while it's in progress.</li> <li>Ensure all required documents listed in the NOFO are uploaded successfully in grants.gov including project and budget narratives.</li> <li>Make sure to compare your organization's capabilities with the eligibility and technical requirements.</li> </ul>
STEP 5		<ul> <li>Await Award Decision</li> <li>Announced by September 30. <u>Track your application</u> submission at Grants.gov.</li> <li>All applications are reviewed by FMCSA for statutory and regulatory compliance, programmatic value, financial soundness, and potential for success.</li> </ul>

## **Application Review**

FMCSA typically conducts the following application review steps:

- 1. Initial screening to ensure application is complete and eligible
- 2. Programmatic review and assessment of the application substance
- 3. Financial review of proposed budgets
