

## Repeat Causal Factors in Past Investigations

#### **Human Factors**

- Fatigue
- Distraction
- Impairment

#### Operations

- Inadequate safety culture
- Improper use of driver monitoring systems
- Lack of fatigue management system

#### Countermeasures - Drivers Should...

- Minimize all distractions and follow federal regulations about cell phone use.
- Follow posted speed limits; drive even slower in bad weather.
- Stay healthy! Take breaks and exercise, manage fatigue, and avoid driving while taking impairing medications —prescription and over-thecounter.
- Wear seatbelts. And ensure your passengers do too!
- Drive sober never get behind the wheel while impaired by drugs or alcohol.

### Owners/Managers Should...

- Implement a fatigue management program based on the North American Fatigue Management Program. (www.CVSA.org).
- Purchase trucks equipped with underride protection, advanced speedlimiting technologies, collision avoidance systems (then train drivers on their use).
- Establish policies to address driver medical fitness for duty.
- If you have installed driver monitoring system, implement a coaching program to improve driver behavior.


