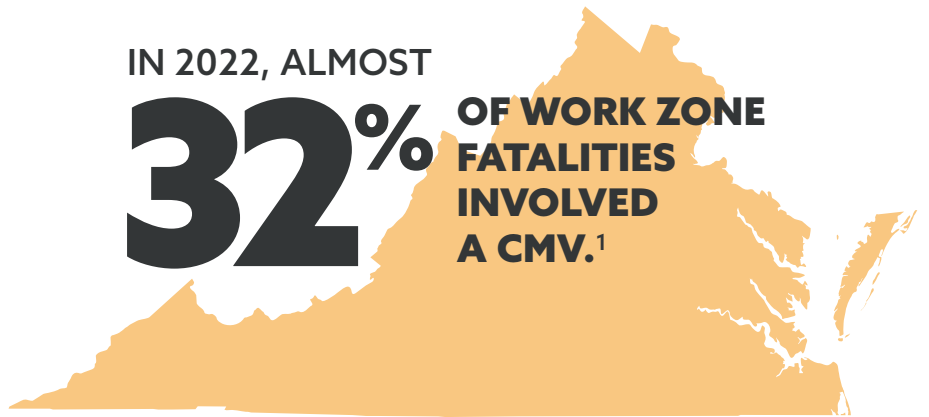


From 2020 to 2021, the number of fatal work zone crashes involving a large truck or bus increased by **39%**.
