STAY SAFE IN WORK ZONES BY FOLLOWING THESE TIPS:



Research your route

Before leaving, set your GPS and avoid work zones where possible.



Pay attention

Work zones have many posted signs along the road. Stay focused and follow their directions.



Avoid distractions

Don't text or call while driving. Keep your hands on the wheel and focus on the drive.



Slow down

Be aware of traffic pattern shifts and control your speed.



Watch for workers

Give road workers extra space, slow down, and prioritize safety.



Be aware of lane closures

Road lanes may shift in work zones. Move into open lanes early.



Stay out of blind spots

Leave extra following distance between vehicles.
