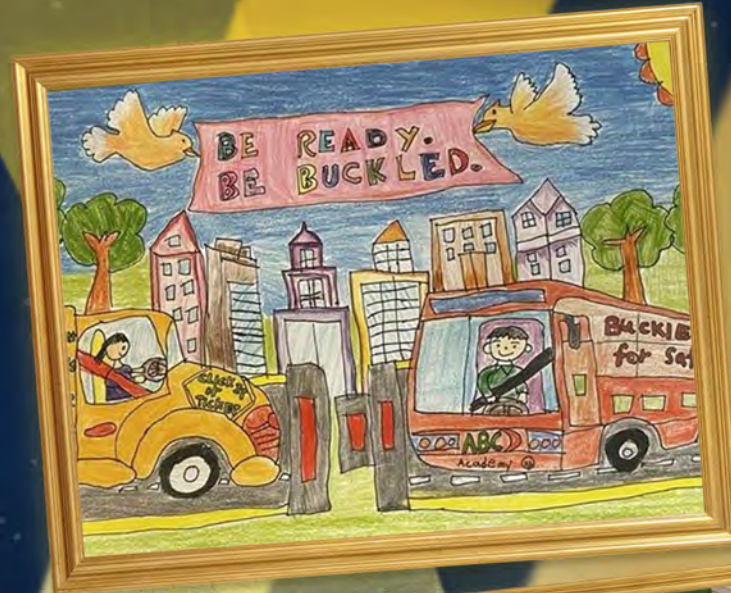

Be Aware Of Blind Spots

Because trucks and buses have large blind spots around all four sides, the safest place for passenger vehicle drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians is either behind or in front of large trucks and buses – don't linger beside large vehicles

Practice Work Zone Safety

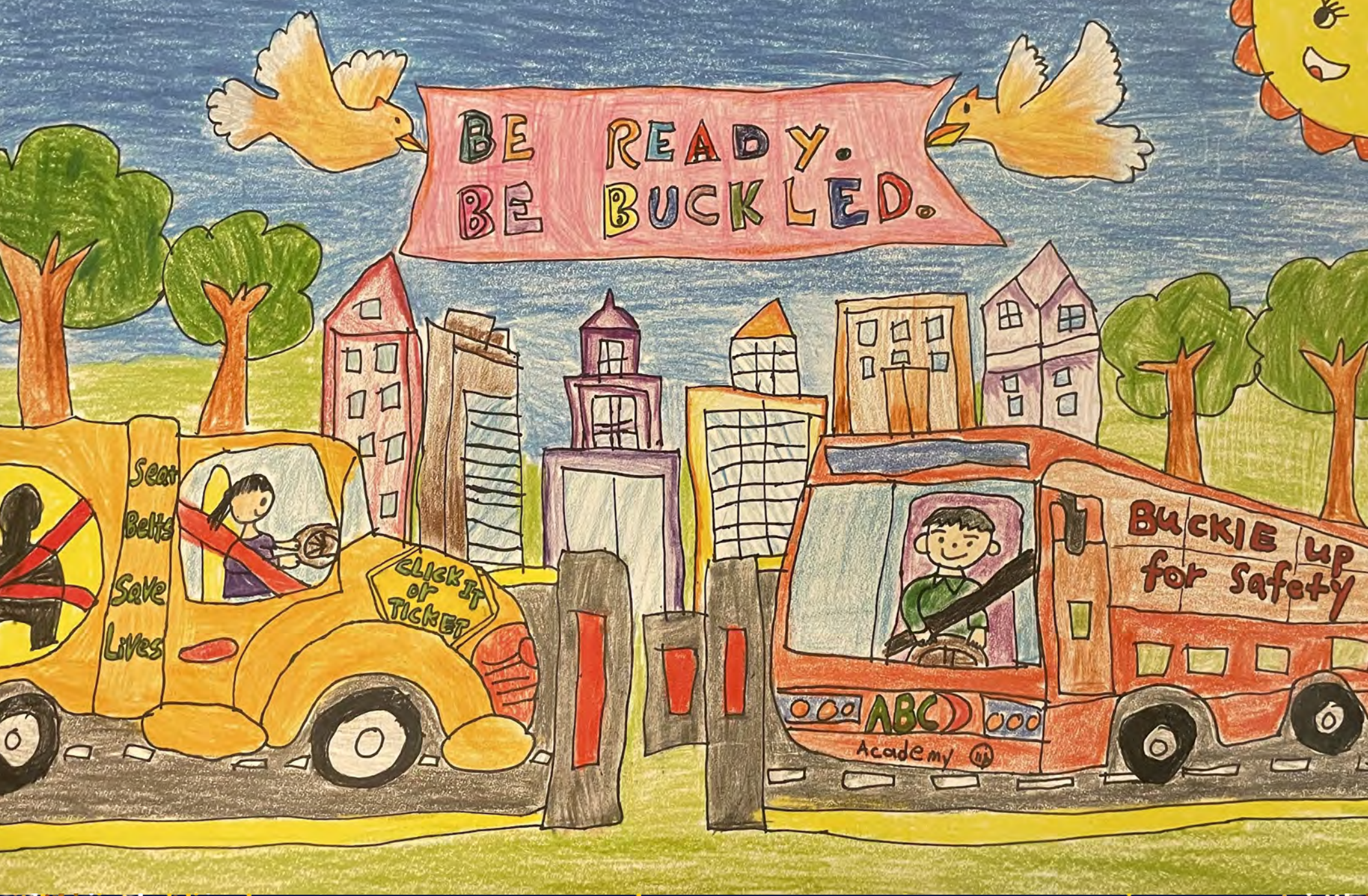
Lane closures, traffic pattern shifts and reduced speeds are common in work zones. Make sure to slow down when entering a work zone and keep an eye out for road workers.

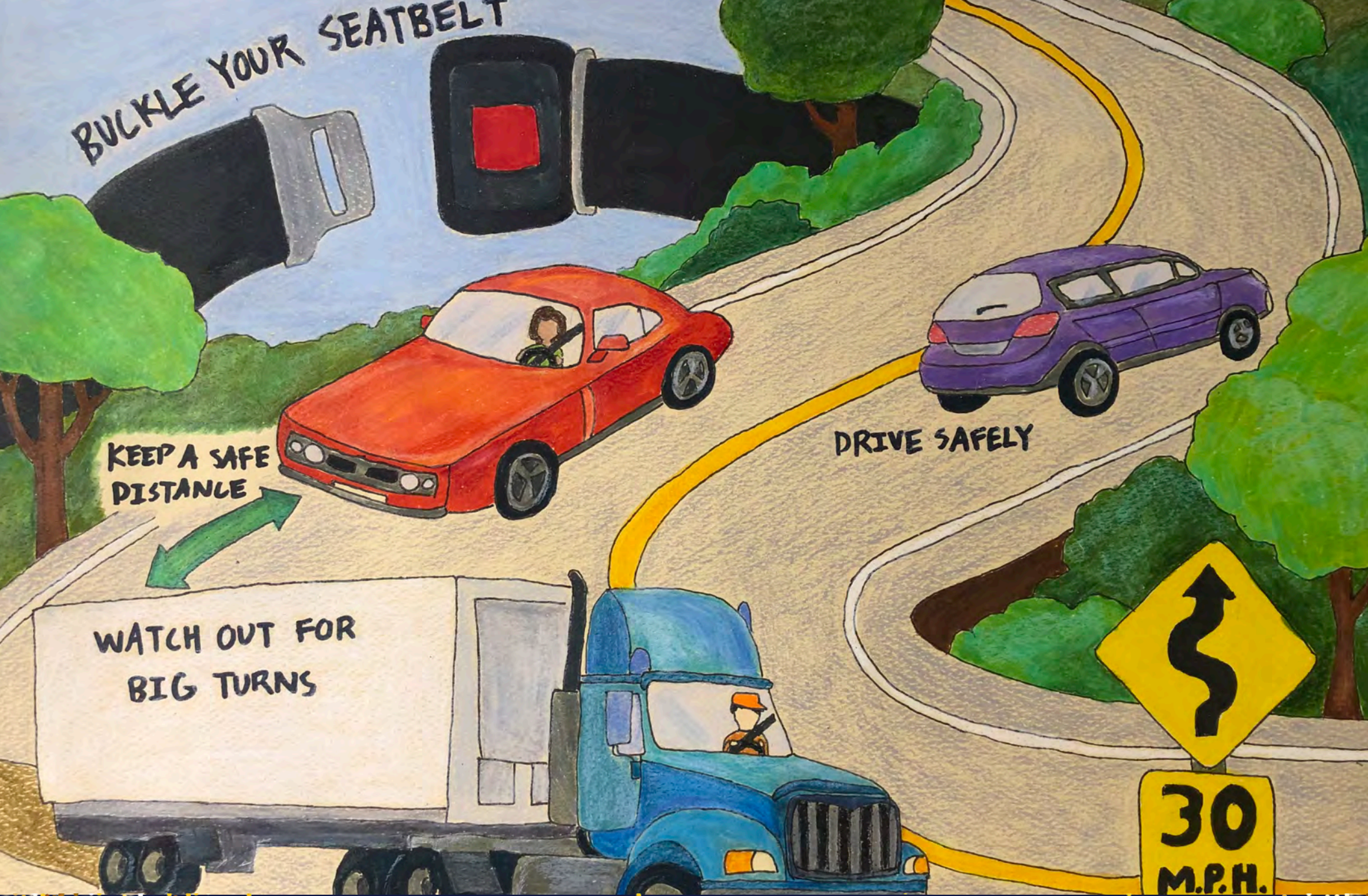
Using a safety belt is one of the easiest and most important things drivers can do to save lives. Make sure all passengers are buckled up, and that kids are in the safest seat based on their age.

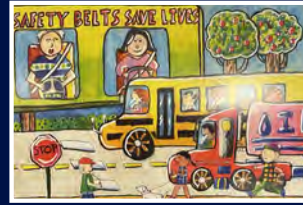

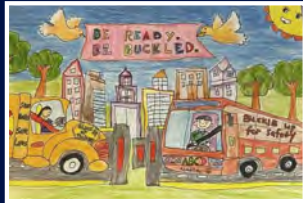

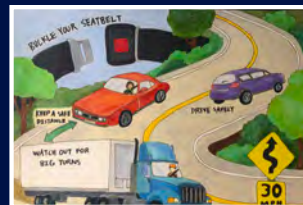
