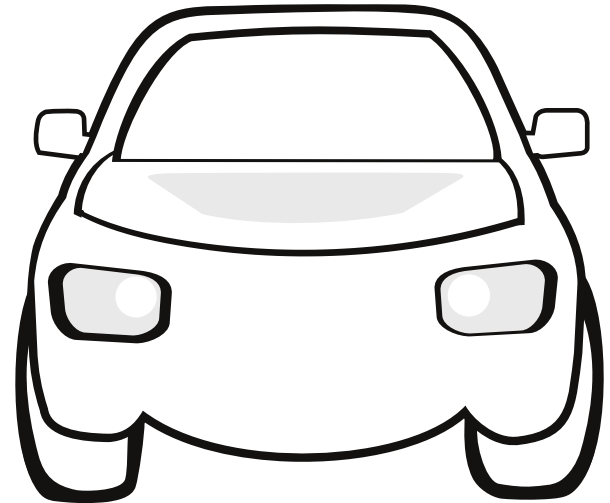
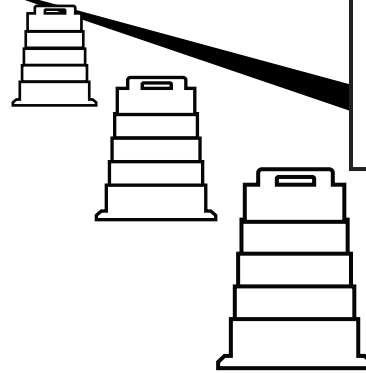


Travel Safely in Work Zones
