

## What you should know before boarding



### ■ EMERGENCY EXITS

There are numerous emergency exits including push out windows and at least one roof hatch that should be used if the door cannot be opened.

### ■ EMERGENCY CONTACT

If necessary, notify authorities of an emergency by calling **911**.

### ■ DRIVER DIRECTION

In the event of an emergency, remain calm and follow the driver's instructions.

### ■ FIRE EXTINGUISHER

A fire extinguisher is located near the front of the vehicle.

### ■ RESTROOM EMERGENCY BUTTON or SWITCH

If you are in the restroom and need assistance, use the button or switch to alert the driver.

### ■ AVOIDING SLIPS AND FALLS

For your safety, please stay seated while the vehicle is in motion. Keep all items including your hands and feet out of the aisle. If you must stand, or move along the aisle, support yourself using the seat backs or overhead supports.
