## Out of Service Report Follow-up and Updates

- In April FMCSA is releasing several new enhancements:
  - QC name search that will allow name search results on not only active, but “inactive” USDOT numbers
  - L&I name search” that will allow names search results to show carriers with more than one OOS reason.
  - Inspector visor cards printed with available tools and queries for identifying OOS carriers roadside.
- Follow-up on “missed catches” concerns from December call
- States without authority under 49CFR385 and/or 386
  - Concept - Separate Report tab for non-385/386 States



## FY 2019 High Priority (HP) Grant Notice

- Both HP Grant opportunity notices (NOFO) have been approved
  - Funding Conference set for March 27<sup>th</sup> – invitations being sent this week
- HP-CMV
  - Available at [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov). Click the tab “search grants”. For the HP-CMV grant, enter the **CFDA number 20.237** and/or Funding opportunity number **FM-MHP-19-001**.
  - Application closing date – April 16, 2019 – 5:00 PM Eastern
- HP-ITD
  - Approved by the Secretary for release on March 6<sup>th</sup>.
  - Anticipate posting to grants.gov within the next two days.

## MCSAP Status Updates

### **FY 2019**

- Full annual appropriation provided by Congress for FY 2019
- FMCSA currently processing NGAs for Phase 1 release
  - Prioritizing distribution for states who have expended all or most of FY 18 funds
- Anticipate releasing remainder of FY 19 funds within the next 60 to 75 days

### **FY 2020**

- FMCSA will follow similar application process from FY 19
  - Release planning/application memo prior to MCSAP Planning Meeting
  - eCVSP anticipated availability on June 3, 2019
  - ALL states will be transitioned to multi-year Plans in FY 2020
