PRISM GUIDE FOR IDENTIFYING REINCARNATED CARRIERS



Legislation

Seek authority to deny registration to potential "reincarnated carriers" attempting to avoid FMCSA enforcement sanctions by obtaining a new DOT number under a different company name and/or Tax ID number.



VIN Check ✓ Process

1. Check every Vehicle Identification (VIN) number in the IRP system against the PRISM Target File to verify if the vehicle is associated with a motor carrier that is under a Federal Out-of-Service (OOS) order.



- 2. If the vehicle is associated with a motor carrier that is under a Federal OOS order, compare the census information of the USDOT number being used to register the vehicle and the USDOT number associated with the Federal OOS order.
- 3. Use the Motor Carrier Management Information System (MCMIS) and/or New Applicant Screening (NAS) to do your information search.



Reincarnated Carrier Check ✓ **Process**

1.	If the motor carrier has 1 census information match marked with an asterisk or any 2 matches,
	deny registration and contact your local FMCSA Division Office (with a copy to PRISM Tech
	Support) for further verification:

Same or similar Company Legal Name and/or DBA Name*
Same Company Officer Name or a relative/spouse *
Physical and/or Mailing Address
Email and/or Phone/Fax/Cellphone Number
Drivers and/or Vehicles

2. If the registrant does not have any census information matches and the registrant provides sufficient evidence that the two motor carriers are not affiliated, send a request to PRISM Tech Support (with a copy to your local FMCSA Division Office) to remove the VIN number from the Target File and proceed with registration.
