

Road Safety Art Contest

IDEAS FOR SAFETY ARTWORK

In creating artwork, children should use one of the themes from the selection below.

1. Draw a big truck or bus sharing the road safely with a car or bicycle.

Hint: Make sure you put a lot of room between the big truck/big bus and the car or bicycle so they are not too close!

2. Draw a truck driver or bus driver smiling at a person who is safely on the sidewalk, or someone on a bicycle riding safely on the road.

Hint: Make sure the person walking or bike rider sees the truck or bus driver too!

3. Draw a truck or bus making a turn in a busy street.

Hint: Make sure the other cars and people are giving the large truck or large bus a lot of room and are not too close!

All drivers and car passengers should be shown wearing a seat belt.

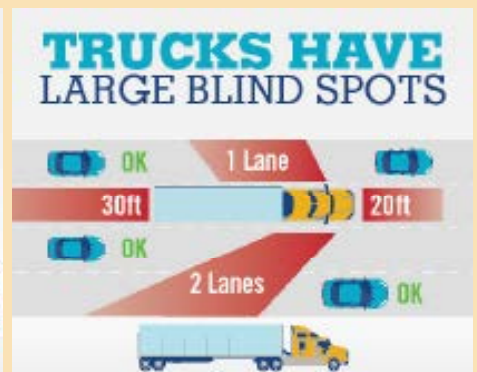
ROAD SAFETY EXAMPLES



Trucks need a long distance to stop safely. Cars should not turn in front of them unless there is plenty of space.



Buses and trucks need a lot of room to turn. Don't ride beside a turning bus.



Trucks have large blind spots. Always make sure the truck driver can see you.
