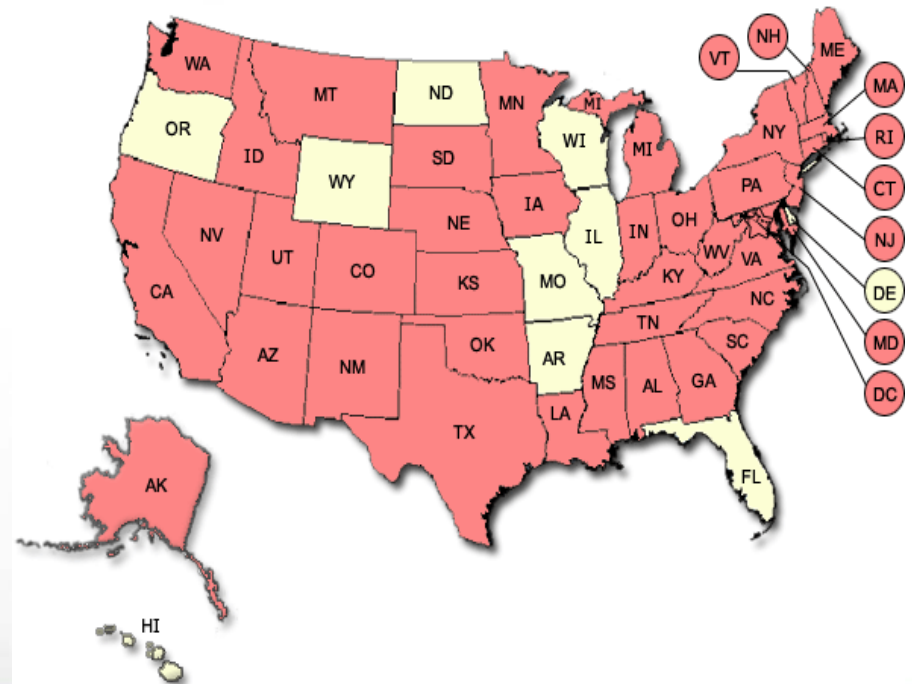

Background

- SaDIP Authorization: Section 4128 of the SAFETEA-LU (Public Law 109-59)
- 80% Federally Funded 20% State Funded
- Discretionary Program
- Eligible Applicants
- All 50 States and,
 - D.C.
 - U.S. Territories





SaDIP Grant Program

- **2006 – \$2 Million – 10 States**
 - AL, AK, DC, ID, KS, ME, MA, MS, NH, RI
- **2007 – \$3 Million – 12 States**
 - AZ, CA, IN, KS, LA, ME, MD, NC, NJ, OK, RI, WA
- **2008 – \$3 Million – 14 States**
 - AL, AZ, IA, ID, IN, KS, KY, MA, MI, NC, NM, NV, TN, VA



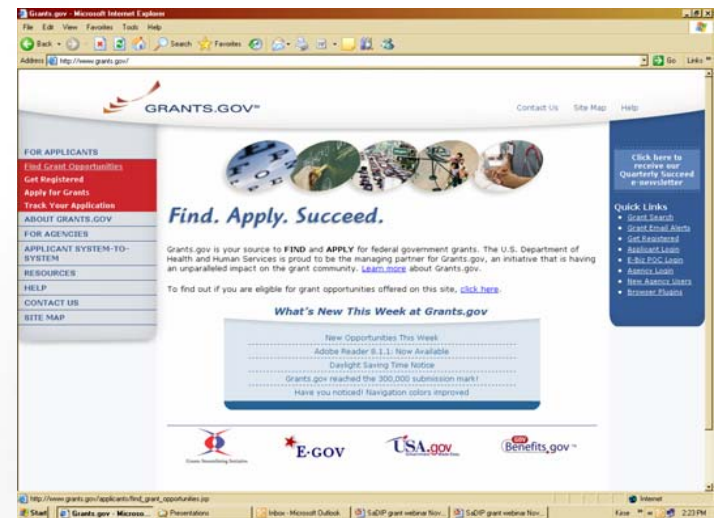
Current SaDIP Grant Projects

- Hire staff to manage data quality improvement projects
- Revise outdated crash report forms
- Hire staff to code and enter accident data
- Train law enforcement in collecting accident data
- Develop software to transfer data
- Purchase equipment to support DQ activities
- Purchase software for data collection and data transfer

- A completed application checklist, including:
 - Letter of Approval from the FMCSA Division Administrator in your State
 - Name of the lead agency and key contact information for the applying agency
 - Project Objective & Implementation Plan
 - Project Timeline and Milestones
 - Budget Information
- All Required Government Standard Forms (SF):
 - SF 424
 - SF 424A
 - SF 424B
 - Disclosure of Lobbying Activities (SF –LLL)
 - Key Contacts Form



SaDIP *Proposal* Requirements

- An Identified Lead Agency
- Project Objective & Implementation Plan
- Project Timeline and Milestones
- Statement regarding Agency's awareness of SSDQ Performance Measures and willingness to address any deficiencies
- Project Budget
- Plan to deliver Quarterly Reports
- Proposal should be valid until date of Award

- All applications must include an approval letter from the FMCSA Division Administrator in your State

- Applications are due on:
 - Friday, January 30, 2009
- Submit comments or questions by close of business: Monday, December 1, 2008.
- Responses will be available on Grants.gov by: Monday, December 15, 2008
- Grant Awards: May 2009
